

COUNTY TRACK CROWN IS WON BY MT. MORRIS

Allen, of Clio, Scores Two Firsts—Fenton Takes Girls' Meet.

Mt. Morris won the Genesee-county high school track and field meet yesterday afternoon at Dort Memorial Field by scoring 40½ points.

Flushing was second with 33 points and Clio was third with 29 points. Otisville, Grand Blanc and Davidson scored 7, 5 and 4 points respectively.

More than 1,000 people gathered to see the biggest meet ever held by the county high schools.

Six county records were broken and others were in danger. Allen, of Clio, set a new record for 100-yard dash by stepping off the distance in 10:3 seconds. Fies, of Flushing, beat the old mark for the 120-yard low hurdles by doing it in 17 seconds. Maginn, of Flushing, won the 880-yard run, setting a new mark of 2:12. Reed, of Clio, set the shot put mark at 36 feet. Layman, of Flushing, cleared 10 feet 3 inches to set a record for the pole vault. Mead of Flushing cleared 5 feet 4½ inches to beat the old high jump mark by ½ inch.

Allen, of Clio, was high scorer of the meet winning two firsts and a second for 13 points.

The girls' meet was won by Fenton with 11 points. Otisville was second with eight and Gaines third with seven.

The track championship cups were awarded to the winners before the start of the championship baseball game. Black received the track and relays cups for Mt. Morris. Miss Hecht received the girls' cup for Fenton. Grand Blanc was awarded the cup for the largest ticket sale.
