## DAVIS, ST. JOE, TAKES SECOND AT ANN ARBOR

Captain Moulty Davis, flashy sprinter at the St. Joseph high school, finished second place in the 100 yard and the 220 yard dashes at the University of Michigan interscholastic meet today at Ann Arbor. Snowden of Detroit Northeastern beat out the Maize and Blue speedster for first place, covering the distance in 1.03:9 and 22.2 respectively. Bennie Simms, St. Joe colored star, failed to place in the 440 yard event. Grimes of Niles took fourth place in the mile run, and Kenney of Niles landed fourth in the discus throw. Briney of St. Joseph took third place in the pole vault, and Monohan of Niles landed fourth place in the javelin throw, which was taken by Turashoff, of Cass Tech, who set a new Michigan interscholastic record with a heave of 166 feet, one inch.
