

**Falcons Win Title

ern, breaking the tape in front of Burgess, of Northwestern. Snowden chalked up his first victory in the 100-yard dash, easily beating Lafayette, of Eastern, while Seres won two points for the Colts. Beatty followed Snowden's lead by winning the 120-yard high hurdles and duplicated in the low hurdles. Both times Simmons, of Redford, was second.

Northwestern's only points in the hurdles were made by Penick who took fourth in the high hurdles. In the semi-finals of the low hurdles, Penick was disqualified for leaving his lane, which cost Northwestern two points and which spelled the margin of victory since he was certain of third place.

Thompson and Guy, of Northwestern, took third and fourth in the half-mile, won by Arnold, of Western, in record time. Northwestern made 27.1-3 of its points in the field events, to 14 for the Falcons.

**Colts' Lead Wiped Out.**

When these were completed, Northwestern held the lead, 42 1-3 to 42. The relay was run in three heats and decided on time. Northwestern, Central and Eastern meeting in the final heat. Snowden got a 10-yard lead on Seres which was narrowed to eight by Meldrum, running against Etkonovitch. Dykas and Penick ran on even terms and Burgess had shaved it to two running against Beatty, but he didn't have the stamina and lost what he had gained in the last 10 yards.
