ROSS PLANS BIG MARATHON SWIM

Chicago, May 26.—(AP)—The man Ross of Chicago, the 1920 Olympic swimming champion, proposes to go Charles "Cash" Pyle, trans-continental derby entrepreneur, one better in marathon promotion. He is planning a long distance swimming race from either Chicago, Pittsburgh, Minneapolis of St. Paul to New Orleans. The race is to start about Aug. 1, with cash prizes totaling \$50,000. There are to be two divisions, one for men and another for women. Under tentative plans, contestants would swim not more than six hours daily with a two-hour stop for lunch and rest. Ross believes the race will last 90 days.
