

Wingert School Girl Wins City Pentathlon

14, High Roberta Brown, Scorer With 4,874 Points in Free Press Event.

(See Picture on Last Page) Roberta Brown, 14, of Wingert school, yesterday afternoon, in competition with mere than 800 girl athletes won the city elemantary school pentathlon championship. The test was held at Codd field, Hazelwood and Byron avenues.

Roberta was one of 10 to earn a gold wrist watch awarded by The Detroit Free Press to girls making the highest scores.

Ten to Get Watches.

The nine girls who will receive vatches, June 1, at the great Belle Isle meet, for their scores yesterday beside Roberta, who made 4,874 points, are Mildred Clark, 14, Field, 4,545; Florence Sonnenberg, 14, Guy-ton, 4,359; Theresa Simmons, 14, Sampson, 4,348; Dorthulah Mills, 15, Garfield, 4,299; Peggy Stanford, 13, Wingert, 4,256; Mildred Bains, 13, Russell, 4,240; Mary Abrams, 14, S. All night service twenty-ninth and Strathmore, 4,222; Eunice Glass, 13, thirtieth. Good roads.—Adv.

T. Houghten, 4,221, and Lovie Gregory, 14, Wingert, 4,202 points.

Roberta's score in five tests follows: Eleven and two-tenths seconds in the obstacle race; 16 seconds in the dash and throw; 12.9 feet in the running broad jump; 140 feet in the baseball throw and 6.2 seconds in the 50-yard dash.

Forty-nine girls won gold, 393 silver and 276 bronze medals. Of the 835 entered in the meet the remainder failed to qualify.

Goodale Champion.

Goodale school won the city pentathlon championship for element-ary schools by entering a team which ran up a total score of 104 points. For every gold medal winner a school was credited with five points, four for each silver medal and three for each bronze medal.
