

N'WESTERN GIRLS WIN TRACK TITLE

Two Records Fall as S'western Is Dethroned.

Northwestern won the sixth annual city high school girls' track and field meet held at Codd field yesterday afternoon with 20 points. Southeastern was second with 14%, and Southwestern, defending champion, third with 11.

Two records were broken. Virginia Anderson, of Highland Park, set a new record in the high jump with a leap of 4 feet 9 inches, 2½ inches better than the mark set by Mattie Tilson, of Northeastern, last year.

Pauline Webster, of Southeastern, accounted for the other in the 60-yard hurdles. Favored by a light wind, she was timed in :08.4, which is six-tenths of a second better than the mark created by Charlotte Balkwell, of Northern, last year.
