This year's track season marks the most complete and also the toughest schedule the local team has ever met. Two dual meets were held, one with Niles in which Three Rivers was defeated 70-52; and one with Sturgis in which the locals triumphed  $74\frac{1}{2}$ - $47\frac{1}{2}$ .

The first big meet was the "Big Five" Conference held at St. Joe in which Three Rivers took third with  $33\frac{1}{2}$  points.

The local team entered the Annual Regional meet at Western State Normal College and qualified six men for the State Meet, namely: Capt. King, Hyatt, Seekell, Combs, DalPonte, and Kugler. Three Rivers can feel very proud that she placed three men in the State meet, Hyatt winning first in the Low Hurdles, Seekell first in the 440 and Combs third in the shot put.
