

STATE TRACK RECORDS FALL IN DETROIT MEET

**Dave Beaubais Takes 30-Yard
Low Hurdles in 4 Sec-
onds at Annual Event.**

Detroit, Feb. 9.—(AP)—Two state A. A. U. indoor track records fell here last night under the flying feet of Dave Beaubais, spring star of the Cadillac A. C., and Noel Maxam of Detroit Northwestern high school, competing in the annual meet of the Detroit department of recreation.

The Cadillac A. C. successfully defended its city championship, with Detroit City college second and Northwestern high third.

Beaubais' new mark was established in winning the 30-yard low hurdles in 4 seconds, one-half second faster than the previous low mark set by Bohn Grim, Michigan State college star, in 1927.

The other new mark was set by Maxam when he stepped 4 feet, 8 3-4 inches in the standing high jump, which was 8 1-8 inches better than the mark set in last year's meet by A. Munroe of the Detroit Y. M. C. A.
