DETROIT YOUTH STARS IN MEET

Beatty, of Northeastern, Tries Iron Man Stunt on Track at Ann Arbor.

Qualifies for Finals in Three Events—Northern Picked to Win.

Ann Arbor, March 15.—(A. P.)—Iron man stunts by Eugene Beatty, Detroit Northeastern, and record breaking by Keller, East Columbus, Ohio, marked the preliminaries for the fifth Michigan interscholastic track and field meet here tonight.

Beatty qualified in three events and because of the numerous preliminaries, was running through most of the hours the preliminaries took. Keller, not satisfied with breaking his record of a year ago in the first preliminary of the high hurdles, made it :08.0 in the semifinals.

Northwestern, Detroit, made itself a decided favorite to win the finals tomorrow by placing men in all events but the shot put. The qualifiers:
