

HURD ESTABLISHES NEW MARK IN MILE

Northwestern Ace Helps Team to Victory at Ann Arbor by Spectacular Race—Beatty, of Falcons, Also Stars.

Froebel, of Gary, Lands Second Place While Northwestern Noses Eastern Out of Fourth Position.

ANN ARBOR, March 16.—While athletes from other schools were turning in most of the outstanding marks, Northwestern high of Detroit walked off with the fifth annual Michigan indoor interscholastic track meet. The Colts placed men in 10 of the 12 events on the program, their superior balance counting heavily to boost their total to 32 points. Following the Northwestern athletes was Froebel high, of Gary,

the Hoosiers running up 23 points in six events. Each of the leaders scored three first places.

A second out-of-state high school, Toledo Scott, breezed in third with 18, just one point ahead of Detroit Northeastern. Columbus Central and Detroit Eastern tied for fifth with 9½ and Columbus East was seventh with eight points.
