

HIGHLAND PARK WINS IN TANK

Bears Shatter Relay Mark to Retain National Swimming Title.

Beatty Sets Hurdle Record as Falcons Land Third in Track.

Chicago, March 23.—Two new champions were crowned and another successfully defended its title in Northwestern university's seventeenth annual inter-scholastic track, swimming and wrestling meet held in Patten gymnasium this afternoon.

Proebel high school, of Gary, Ind., won first place in the track events with 18½ points. Oak Park was second with 13 points, and Northeastern high of Detroit placed third with 11. Northwestern high of Detroit was next with 9 1-3 and Detroit Eastern scored 8 1-3 points.

Twenty-five of the 45 teams entered in the track meet figured in the scoring column.

For the second successive year Highland Park high school of Detroit ran away with the swimming meet, piling up 34 points. Chisholm, Minn., nosed out Schurz, of Chicago, for second place, with 16 points, the latter taking third, with 15 points.

Tulsa, Okla., with a well balanced team, which placed men in six of the 10 final bouts, won the
