

Only One New Record Likely In City Meet

One mark is expected to fall when high school athletes of the city compete in their annual meet at Central high school Wednesday and Saturday of this week. Cavanaugh's unofficial record for the mile run, is the one most seriously endangered. He ran the distance in 4:48 1/5 in the 1927 city meet, two seconds better than the mark set by Ruckstahl of Northwestern at the latter school in 1924 but his mark isn't listed among the records in the athletic manual. A checkup will be made this week it was indicated yesterday by Vaughn S. Blanchard, Metropolitan league head.
