

**DEARBORN WINS
FORDSON MEET**

... tied with Fordson for fifth, each getting eight points. Wyandotte, two places behind Dearborn in the state Class B championships last year, was sixth with six one point ahead of Paul Huron, in eighth place. Foyal Oak totaling five and one-half.

Three Not in Scoring.

Saginaw Eastern, the fifth Class A entry, had the smallest score of the meet, gaining only five-eighths of a point through Anderson's place in an eight-way tie for third in the high jump. Rochester, Salina of Dearborn and Zeeve failed to score a point, while Trenton's squad didn't appear for the meet.

In the preliminaries of the Midwest meet at Ann Arbor Friday, Jackson made a leap of 21 feet, 7.4 inches and believing he would be unable to better it, reserved his energy for the Fordson meet Saturday. His mark wasn't bettered in the finale yesterday while he was competing at Fordson where he won the broad jump and ran second in the 200.

That one of five to qualify for the finale in the discus in the preliminaries at Ann Arbor Friday afternoon, was in the Fordson meet Saturday morning where he put the shot 42 feet and threw the discus 121 feet in the early trials, which stood the afternoon's onslaught, netting two trials and still had time to go to Ann Arbor where he placed fourth in the discus.

Each Score Three Firsts.

The fourth first made by Dearborn was scored by Wilson in the 220-yard low hurdles.

Ann Arbor, Pontiac and Grand Rapids South, each accounted for three firsts. Zanco in the 220 and Hamilton in the deciding event, the high jump, accounted for Ann Arbor's. Everhard in the 120 high hurdles and the half-mile relay set score Grand Rapids South's while Pontiac's both came in the field events, Martin winning the pole vault and Mogg the javelin.

Third's Heave Beters Mark.

The two other firsts of the meet were divided by Fordson and Wyandotte, Martin winning the century for Fordson and the mile medley relay, accounting for the Pontiac victory.

Third's discus heave was the only one better than that made in the state Class B meet last year, exceeding it by 11 feet. A slow track due to recent heavy rains was part of the blame.

The discus was won by Martin (Fordson), who outdistanced Jim Brown (Grand Rapids) and for second, McCall (Farmington) and third, Zanco (Ann Arbor). The mile medley relay was won by Zanco (Ann Arbor), second, Jackson (Dearborn), second, Martin (Pontiac), third, Sherman (Grand Rapids).

Shot, 42 Feet.

The 220-yard low hurdles—won by Shaw (Dearborn), Crawford (Ann Arbor) and O'Brien (Huron Oak), tied for second, 47th (Farmington), fourth, Vines, 52th, by Howard (Grand Rapids South); Rice (Huron Oak), second, Crawford (Ann Arbor), third, Jackson (Dearborn), fourth.
