

COLTS CAN TIE TRACK RECORD

Northwestern Has Chance To Score in Every Event in City Meet.

Northwestern High today has an opportunity to equal an athletic feat which has been accomplished but once in eight city championship track and field meets. It has a chance to place in every event of the scholastic meet at Codd Field.

Only once has a city school been able to accomplish this and Northwestern was the school which did it, placing in every event of the 1925 meet. Not before or since has another team approached this record.

Northwestern qualified in every event of the elimination trials Friday. The Colts placed four men in the 100-yard dash, two in the 120-yard high hurdles, the same number in the low hurdles, four in the 220, one in the 440, one in the 880, two in the pole vault, two in the discus throw, two in the javelin throw, two in the high jump, three in the hammer throw, and one in the broad jump, one in the shot put. No trials were held in the mile run or the relay.

No school approached Northwestern's total of 27 qualifiers. As a result, the Colts should have no trouble running off with the team honors which they lost to Northeastern last year.

Despite excellent weather conditions no new meet records were established in Friday's trials. One mark was equalled, Crawford of Redford throwing the hammer 140 feet 2 inches, to tie a record made by Howard Hamilton of Eastern High in 1923.

In the finals today, however, there is more than a possibility that new marks will be set in the mile run, in which Otto Pongrace of Eastern and Wesley Hurd of Northwestern, the two best milers in this section of the country, will clash; in the high jump, discus throw and possibly both hurdle events.
