

FENTON GAINS COUNTY TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP

Points in Field Events Gives Team Edge Over Mt. Morris —Haddon Stars.

Greater strength in the field events enabled Fenton high school to nose out Mt. Morris for the county outdoor track championship, 48 1-3 points to 43 1-2; Flushing, last year's winner, finished third with 32 1-3 markers. The competition took place mainly between these three schools, the other entries registering as follows: Clio, 8; Davison, 5; Montrose, 4, and Grand Blanc, 2. The meet was held yesterday afternoon at Dort Memorial field under the auspices of Flint Junior college.

Haddon, of Fenton, the bright star of the meet, captured four firsts and set two new meet records. He bettered the century mark by 2-10 of a second and clipped a full second off of the old 220-yard dash time.

Mt. Morris high school captured the girl's track championship from Fenton, nosing out the latter team 13 to 9. The other schools placed in the following order, Grand Blanc, 8; Davison, 6; Flushing, 5; Genesee, 3, and Clio, 2.
