

# WYANDOTTE TAKES DOWN RIVER MEET

## Roosevelt High Scores 50 1-2 Points and Keeps Cup.

Wyandotte high school won the sixth annual down-river invitational track meet held on the Wyandotte field Saturday afternoon, by scoring 50½ points. River Rouge was second with 40½; Fordson third with 18, Trenton placed fourth with 11, and Ecorse trailed with six.

This is the sixth successive year that Wyandotte has won the meet. The Ehrlich cup, furnished by the Ehrlich Jewelry company, becomes the permanent possession of the Wyandotte Roosevelt high school by virtue of winning it for the third consecutive year.

Earl Sonnenburg, of Wyandotte, was high point winner with a total of 10½ points. Ramsay of River Rouge and Martin of Fordson were tied for second honors with 10 points each.
