ALGONAC WINS ST. CLAIR MEET

Six Records Fall As 100 Compete At Tashmo

Tashmo Park, June 8—Six records were broken in the annual St. Clair county field meet here Friday in which 100 athletes took part from St. Clair, Marine City and Algonac. St. Stephen of Port Huron did not enter a single event. About 500 attended.

Algonac High school won the field meet in the boys' events with 244 points to St. Clair's 211, the nearest opponent. Marine City won 13 points.

Gilson Pearsall of Algonac broke the pole vault record of 19 feet by adding one inch. Alvin Chase for St. Clair clipped 5 2-5 seconds from the 440-yard run when he came in the fast time of 2:15.2.

Jack Moore for St. Clair was the outstanding star of the meet as far as breaking records go. He threw the discus 117 feet 14 inches to overshadow the former record of 100 feet, 1 inch.

St. Clair walked away with the honors in the girls' events with 424 points to Marine City's 204 points and breaking two records. Bevela Fraker threw the baseball 150 feet to outdistance the former record by five feet four inches. Hilda Moore made 12 feet, 11 1/2 inches in the running broad jump as compared with the former record of 13 feet 2 1/4 inches.
