1930 TRACK

This year's track season was the best in the history of our school. The team ran its first meet at the Western State Teachers College Relay Carnival, and won with 22½ points. The Mid-West Invitational Meet was the big event of the year. In this they met competition from other states and took fourth place with 12 points. After winning high honors in the first two invitational meets they went to the State Regional and gained 52 points. Winning the Regional Meet made them eligible for the state finals. Two men made places in this meet.

The last event of the season was the Five-A League Meet at Ann Arbor. Eastern won this meet, with as enviable a record as she usually makes, 58 points.
