

# NORTHWESTERN IS LEADER

One new city record was established and two old marks tied in the preliminaries of the annual high school track and field meet at Central yesterday. As the result of their playing 18 men and a relay team in the finals Northwestern is overwhelming favorite to pile up a record total Saturday night.

Willis Ward, Northwestern's leading athlete, set a new mark in the low hurdles. Ward's time for the event was 34-5 seconds. The old record was made in 1920 by Day of Northwestern. In 1926 Charles Ross, also of Northwestern, equalled it and last year Northwestern's great star, Eugene Beatty, covered the distance in 4 seconds flat.

## TIES HIGH MARK

Ward also tied the city mark in the 30-yard high hurdles. This mark of 41-5 seconds was made by Day in 1920, and equalled by Prout of Central in 1923. Vallmore of Northwestern, running in one of the heats, tied Ward's best effort.

Hershey of Western, considered the city's best quarter miler, tied the city record for this event, covering the distance in :54 2-5. Lean Dykas of Northeastern, holder of the city record, was second in the time reckonings.
