

## RECORD BROKEN IN PREP TRIALS

**Willis Ward Lowers 30-Yard  
Low Hurdle Mark by One-  
fifth Second.**

**Northwestern Leads List in  
Placing Men for Finals  
Saturday Night.**

One city record was broken and two were tied Wednesday afternoon at Central high in the preliminaries to the Tenth Annual Interscholastic Indoor Track meet.

Willis Ward, of Northwestern, broke the record in the 30-yard low hurdles by lowering the mark to 3 and 4-5.

Ward and Erwin Valmore tied the record of :04 1-5 seconds in the 30-yard high hurdles. Merrill Hershey, of Western, tied Leon Dykas' record of :54 2-5 seconds in the 880. Dykas himself did this event in :55 seconds flat, but didn't exert himself in the last two laps.

James Carr, of Redford, gave all he had to win over Wesley Hurd and the rest of the field of competitors in the mile run. As a result of his victory over Hurd, Carr is placed a favorite to capture the final of this event. Hurd, however, may upset all dope, as he did last year when he out-ran the field and made a new record.

The 30-yard dash mark may be erased Saturday evening as William Fisher, of Northwestern, and Robert Palmer, of Hamtramck, did this event in :03 4-5 seconds, while the record is :03 2-5. The Colts are the favorites to win the city
