Leon Dykas of Northeastern and Merle Hershey of Western finished the 440-yard run so close officials went into a conference before deciding that Dykas had nosed out the Western quarter-miler. Dykas broke the old record of :54 2-5 set by Hershey last week in the pre-liminaries, by one-fifth of a second. Noel Maxam of Northwestern soared over 11 feet 5% inches for a new pole vault record. The old mark set by Prout in 1923 and tied by Marsh in 1926 was 11 feet 3 inches, was not threatened in the past three years.
