

## RECORDS FALL AT PREP MEET

**Willis Ward Sets New World's  
Interscholastic Mark in  
High Jump.**

**Maxan Clears Bar in Pole Vault  
at 11.6 to Better Old  
Record.**

Four city and one world's scholastic records were shattered and another city mark tied Saturday night as Northwestern was piling up points to win the annual Metropolitan prep school track meet at Central high gymnasium.

Willis Ward, all-around athlete at Northwestern high, shattered the city as well as the world's scholastic mark in the high jump when he cleared the bar at six feet, four inches, which falls a few inches short of reaching the all time mark. This performance broke the city mark of five feet, 11 inches held jointly by Ware of Hamtramck and Sampson of Cass, made in 1928.

Ward also tied the city record in the 30-yard high hurdles when he covered the distance in 4 1-5 seconds. This record was set in the preliminaries the first of the week.

Noel Maxan of Northwestern broke the city pole vault mark, clearing the bar at 11 feet, six inches. The old record was 11 feet, three inches, established in 1923.

Leo Zykas, of Northeastern bettered the city record in the 440-yard dash, being clocked :53 3-5
