

THREE RIVERS IS CLOSE 2ND WITH 33 PTS.

McNutt, Allegan Athlete,
Leads Individual Scoring
With 15 Points

South Haven today rules over the track and field teams in the Big Six conference, a group of southwestern class B schools, as champion. The South Haven club scored 36½ points, while Three Rivers, the second place team, was next in line with 33 points.

Cochs Hank Howe's St. Joseph team was third with 25½ points. Allegan was next in line with 25 points, while Niles, the defending champion, finished a poor fifth with 15 points. Dowagiac was in the cellar position in the standings with 13 points.

Four New Records
The meet was held at Raichliffe field in South Haven and a large number of fans witnessed the events, which resulted in four new conference records.

St. Joseph scored good form and copped three first places and a tie for the fourth. South Haven, the new champion, topped the list by copping four first marks.
