

# NORTHWESTERN IS TRACK CHAMP

ners tied for third and five tied for sixth.

Wesley Hurd, Northwestern's mile ace, led in his event by a scant foot over James Carr of Redford in the feature race of this event. Rounding the final curve before going into the stretch Hurd cut in in front of the Redford runner and the judges disqualified the Colt.

The disqualification of Hurd not only cost Northwestern a chance to collect points in the event, but took first from the individual.

Hurd will be allowed to compete in the state meet at Lansing next Saturday, it was ruled by George Meade, director of high school athletics, after the meet. Redford finished first in the team standings. Highland Park scored their first point of the meet by finishing second. Hamtramck was third and Central fourth.

Leon Dykas, Northeastern's stellar middle-distance runner, led the field in the 440-yard dash. His time was 52 seconds, 1 1-5 seconds slower than the record. Hershey, winner of second place, was a mere six inches behind and clocked at the same time as the winner. Northeastern won team honors, with Redford second, Northwestern third and Eastern fourth.

Ward broke his second record in the 120-yard low hurdles. He topped the timbers in 13 seconds flat. The old mark was 13 2-5.

Ray Roe of Northwestern set the other record in the 880.
