

**TRACK CHAMPIONS
DECIDED IN MEET**

**Alma, Lowell and Middleton
Win at Mt. Pleasant.**

Mt Pleasant, May 17.—Alma in Class B, Lowell in C and Middleton in Class D are the three new track champions of Central Michigan crowned at the regional meet held Saturday at Central State Teachers' college. Middleton had to fight to the last, collecting 56½ points to 49 for Akron. Maple Rapids took 15½ and Crystal 13 in Class D.

Scoring 23 points in the high and low hurdles and the mile, Alma swept through the Class B field to garner 53 points. Mt. Pleasant just edged Caro out for second, 40 points to 37½, while Ionia picked up 10 points, Midland 7, and St. Johns 3½.

Lowell made it a runaway in Class C with 68 1-5 points. Rockford was second with 28 7-10 and Breckenridge third with 22½. Carson City annexed 12 1-5 points, Belding 9 2-5 and Grant 2.

Rajkovich, Caro star, tossed the javelin 154 feet, outstripping the Class B field. In Class C Layer and Elggs, both of Lowell, tied for first in the javelin, with heaves of 138 feet.

In all three relays the two first teams finished within a foot of each other, Mt. Pleasant nosing out Caro in Class B, Lowell beating Rockford in C, and Middleton skinning past Akron in D. In the latter race Garcia, midget Mexican star, dived through to victory.
