Griffith of Rochester triumphed in the broad jump with a leap of 19 feet 7½ inches. This event and the discus which was won by Hanson of Dearborn, Hanson hurled the plate 113 feet one one inch.

Hanson staged a hard fought duel with Pearsil of Algonac in the pole vault the former winning 11 feet, setting the eighth and last record of the day and clinching high point honors.
