

LANSING PREPS LEAD THE WAY

**Bag Most Points in Top Class
of School Meet at
Western State.**

**Otsego High in Second Class—
Hoff and Adams Star
for Leaders.**

Kalamazoo, May 3.—(A. P.)—Good records were established here this afternoon as nearly 500 athletes from 38 Michigan high schools competed in the first annual Western State Teachers college relay carnival.

The honors were well divided in Class one, which was open to athletes of Class A and Class B rank, and in Class 2, which included schools ranked as Class C and Class D by the Michigan high school athletic association. Points were not officially announced, as no team championships were provided for, but newspapermen found Lansing Eastern, in Class one, and Otsego, in Class 2, were high, according to the usual method of scoring. Lansing Eastern had 22 points, one point more than Kalamazoo Central and Muskegon Heights, who divided second position. Otsego totaled 25 points, five more than St. Augustine high of Kalamazoo, second place winner in Class 2.

Individual prowess of Frank Hoff, Lansing Eastern, and Adams, Otsego, put their schools on top. Hoff won the 120-yard hurdles, the broad jump and was third in the high jump in the open events, and anchored the winning mile relay team. In other open events, Adams, Otsego, was first in the javelin, tied with Fairfield, Muskegon Heights, in the discus and was third in the shot.
