NORTHWESTERN IS LEADER

ANN ARBOR, May 10.—For the third time in the last four years, Detroit Northwestern outdistanced competitors in the preliminary heats of the annual University of Michigan Interscholastic Track and Field tourney, and were distinct favorites to win in the finals today.

The Colts qualified in 11 places for the closing events, pursued by Toledo Scott, with nine qualifiers, and Ann Arbor with 6. Other Detroit schools to place men in the finals were Cass Tech and Western three each, Northeastern two and University of Detroit and Southeastern, one each.

In the only event in which finals were run off Friday, the hammer throw, Northwestern pulled down five points, when McCord tossed the 12-pound weight 123 feet 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches for first place. Shower of Detroit Southeastern took second, Kyros of Redford third, and Londke of Detroit Western, fourth. The distance was far short of the record.

None of the times and distances recorded in the preliminaries even approached record performances, the exhibition falling far short of previous years. Willis Ward, lanky Northwestern jumper and hurdler, qualified in three events and gave indication of being high point man when the totals are counted. He was given little competition in either of the barrier races, this probably accounting for the slow times made.
