

# TRACK VICTORY TO CASS CITY

## Carries Off Honors In Annual Event Of Upper Thumb Association

Caro, Mich., June 14—Cass City high school track team duplicated its performance of a year ago by winning the third annual field day of the Upper Thumb association here Friday. Only a point and a fraction separated the winning team from Caro, second in the meet.

Points won by the different schools totaled as follows: Cass City 53 3-12, Caro 52 1-3, Crosswell 16 1-2, Bad Axe 12 3-4 Marlette 6, Sebewalng 2.

The last event of the day, the relay race, decided championship honors, Cass City winning the event, Caro taking second place.

### New Records Set

New records for the association were set in the following events: 500-yard run, by Lewis, Crosswell, 2 minutes 11.5 seconds; javelin throw, Rajkovich, Caro, 144 feet 6 inches; running high jump, McDurmon, Caro, 5 feet 8 9-16 inches; shot put, Rajkovich, Caro, 41 feet 1-2 inch; discus throw, Edgerton, Cass City, 109 feet 7 3-4 inches; half mile relay, Cass City, 1 minute 36 seconds.

Other firsts were won as follows: 120 yard low hurdles, McDurmon, Caro; pole vault, McCrea, Caro; mile run, Roerr, Cass City; 440 yard dash, Edgerton, Cass City; 220 yard dash, Moore, Caro; broad jump, Woodworth, Crosswell; 100 yard dash, Moore, Caro. Edgerton of Cass City was high point man of the meet with 13 counters.
