

Frank Hoff Stars In Defiance Meet

DEFIANCE, OHIO, April 27. — Frank Hoff, jr., slender athlete from Lansing Eastern high school, was the sensation of the invitational track and field meet held at Defiance College here Saturday. Hoff won individual honors in competition which attracted the best thin clad talent from the large high schools in Ohio and Indiana.

The Quaker track star won both the high and low hurdle events and the broad jump. His time in the 120-yard high hurdles was 16.6 and he covered the 120-yard low hurdle course in 14.0. His distance in the broad jump was 20 feet 6½ inches.

Score 19 Points

Steward Frankford, placed second in the 880-yard run and Kaiser was fourth in the mile run to give Lansing 19 points. The other Quakers found the competition too stiff.

Eastern ranked about third among the schools entered and was the only Class A team from Michigan which competed. Columbus, C., Central won the meet and Scott high of Toledo, O., was second. The Quakers thinclads were on a par with such schools as Wade and Libby high schools of Toledo.
