

TRACK MEET WON BY SOUTHEASTERN

Jungaleers Score 63 Points in Quadrangular Event.

Southeastern high school trackmen emerged the victors in a quadrangular meet Thursday afternoon at Cood field, running up 63 points. Northern high was second to the Jungaleers with 43½ points. Northeastern took third with 31½, while University of Detroit high was far in the rear, scoring only seven points.

Sam Sachs, of Northern, was high point man for the afternoon when he accounted for 14 points in four events. The versatile Eskimo scored nearly one-third of his team's total. He won the 100-yard dash and the broad jump, placed third in the discus throw, took fourth in the shot put, and ran on the winning half-mile relay team.

Bird, of Southeastern, led his team in scoring with seven points. It was all-around team balance rather than individual brilliance that won the meet for the Jungaleers.
