

**PREP ATHLETES V  
SET RECORDS**

**Four Marks Fall, One Equalled  
in State Meet at East  
Lansing.**

**Pantlind, Grand Rapids, Takes  
120 High Hurdles in  
:15.8.**

East Lansing, May 22.—Four new records were established and one old mark equalled as several hundred boys opened competition in the annual state high school track and field meet in the Michigan State college stadium this afternoon. Two of the records were in class C and one each came in class A and class D.

Only four finals were held this afternoon, the horde of talent running through preliminary tests that cut the field of competitors to manageable proportions for the championships which will be decided tomorrow, starting at 10 o'clock.

**Pantlind Lowers Mark.**  
The best record of the day was hung up by Boyd Pantlind, Grand Rapids Central hurdler, who raced over the 120-yard high sticks in the time of 15.8 to win his heat. This beat the mark of 16 flat made by Spence of Detroit Western seven years ago. Pantlind also led the 220-yard low hurdle field.

Hinchman of Northville pushed the shot out 45 feet 1 inch and McCorry of Ontonagon heaved the discuss 121 feet 7 inches for new class C records. Chase of South Lake accounted for the other record by turning in the time of :14.8 for the 120-yard low hurdles, a special event for the class D schools.

**Monroe Does Well.**  
In one of the four finals staged, Powers of Mt. Pleasant and Williams of Hastings shared first place in the class B high jump, equaling the record of 5 feet 9 inches.

Monroe high school, class B champions last year but competing in class A this spring, moved into the spotlight in the preliminaries by qualifying eight men for the finals. Monroe was out in front while two Grand Rapids teams, Central and Union, were runners-up with five each. There were 18 schools that qualified athletes, indicating a wide division of points tomorrow.

Grand Haven and South Haven, with eight qualifiers each, loomed as favorites for the class B throne vacated by Monroe. The class C field was scattered, but South Lake led in class D with six qualifiers.
