## VICTORY SCORED IN LAST EVENT

Monroe Scores 28 Points, Grand Rapids Central 26, Muskegon 24

## STEIN'S FIRST WINS MEET

The Monroe High track team has won the highest honor that it is possible for it to get, the State Class A Championship. This is the first year that the team has competed in such fast company but because of their balance in all events they brought the first Class A trophy to Monroe. By winning the meet at East Lansing last Friday and Saturday the Red and White track and field team repeated its victory of a year ago, the only difference being that this year they competed against the strongest schools in the state with the exception of Detroit schools who are unable to enter competitive events outside of Detroit.

The meet was not determined until the last event, the pole vault, was finished. After all of the events except this one had been completed the total scores were: Grand Rapids Central 26, Muskegon 24, and Monroe 23. Captain Ray Stein vaulted to the height of 11 ft. 8½ in., his best height this year, to win the event from a Pontiac man.

Monroe's final score was 28, Grand Rapids, second, 26. Other teams in the Class A competition finished in the following order: Muskegon 24, Kalamazoo Central 20, Grand Rapids Union 20, Ann Arbor 14, Grand Rapids South 12, Lansing Eastern 12, Grosse Pointe 9, Grand Rapids Ottawa Hills 8, Pontiac 8, Benton Harbor 6, Jackson 5, Muskegon Heights and Saginaw Arthur Hill 4, Lansing Central 2, and Fordson 1-3.

Two first places were taken by the Monroe team, Tony Roberts taking the 220 yd. dash and Ray Stein the pole vault. Roberts was high point man for the Red and White team with one first, a second in the 100 yd. dash, a fifth in the discus, and a place on the Monroe relay team which placed third.

The track team meets some of these same schools in the S. E. A. A. meet next Saturday and they are predicted to win with Pontiac giving them a close race.
