

### RECORDS AT LOCAL MEET ARE BETTER

#### Ironwood, Wakefield to Enter Iron Mountain Event Next Week.

Evidence that Gogebic range chinchids may offer serious opposition to other Upper Peninsula teams when they clash at Iron Mountain next week in the Peninsular invitational track and field meet is given in comparative scores registered last Saturday. Iron Mountain and Escanaba, two of the leading teams in the Delta-Dickinson district, dominated a quadrangular event at Escanaba, while Ironwood was running off with the Gogebic meet here. Incidentally, the records established at the local meet were in some cases better than the records hung up at the Class B state meet in Lansing.

**Range Teams Enter**  
Both Ironwood and Wakefield will send teams to Iron Mountain. Hurley would also like to enter the meet, but may not be able to do so because of the fact that the Lincoln high school is locked just across the border.

Because it was reported here this week that Arthur Ahonen had made his last local appearance as a Luther L. Wright representative queries have been made whether the local high school star would take part in the Iron Mountain meet. Assurance was given today by Luther L. Wright high school officials that Ahonen will complete his academic career at the Iron Mountain meet.

A comparison of records established at Ironwood and Escanaba indicates the Gogebic range boys' record marks set up at the Delta-Delta county meet in eight of 13 events.

**Records Are Compared**  
A comparison of the first place winners at the two meets follows:

- 2. 150 yard dash—L. Johnson, Iron Mountain, 10.7; Ahonen, Ironwood, 18.8.
- 3. 200 yard dash—L. Johnson, Iron Mountain, 7.7; Ahonen, Ironwood, 17.5.
- 4. 400 yard dash—Christensen, Escanaba, 38.6; Ross, Hurley, 41.6.
- 5. 800 yard dash—L. Johnson, Iron Mountain, 24.1; Wakefield, 24.7.
- 6. High jump—Grandahl, Iron Mountain, five feet, eight inches; Rowe, Ironwood; Maurin, Escanaba, tied at five feet, seven inches.
- 7. Pole vault—Anderson, Escanaba, 12.7 feet, four and one-half inches; Ahonen, Ironwood, 16.8 feet, eight inches.
- 8. 800 yard run—Morton, Escanaba, 21.4; Williams, Ironwood, 21.5.
- 9. Broad jump—Bellarsen, Escanaba, 21 feet, one inch; Wynn, Ironwood, 20 feet, one inch.
- 10. 800 yard race—Iron Mountain, 1.36.5; Ironwood, 1.41.5.
- 11. Stockton, Cal.—Eddie Murdock of Oklahoma City, stopped Claude Cobb.
