MONROE, May 14—Monroe High School captured the triangular track meet here Saturday afternoon, scoring 60½ points, Ann Arbor and Wyandotte finishing second and third, making 58 and 11½ points respectively.

Harsant Tantsi, of Ann Arbor, with 13½ points, was the high point man of the meet. Harold Stein, of Monroe, vaulted 11 feet and 10 inches to establish a new field record here, being the highest ever attained by a Monroe vaulter. Shot put record was broken by E. Darling, of Ann Arbor, while G. Morris, of Ann Arbor, broke the record in 440-yard dash. The mile race was won by Carl Balk, of Monroe.
