

# HONORS DIVIDED IN ANNUAL JUNIOR TRACK CARNIVAL

## McKinley, Whittier and Emerson Split Titles; Relays Decide Winners.

Honors in the annual Junior High schools track meet were well divided yesterday afternoon as six city schools fought it out for titles in the three divisions, seventh, eighth and ninth grades. McKinley won the ninth grade championship by noting Lowell out by half a point, 19 1-2 to 19. Whittier tied with Emerson for the eighth grade title, each school gaining 18 markers and in the seventh grade division, Whittier scored 24 points to 19 for Lowell.

The outcome of the ninth grade contest was in doubt until the final event, when Whittier placed second in the 440-yard relay while Lowell was third. Emerson was forced to step out and win the relay in the eighth grade contest in order to gain its tie for first place.

Whittier scored firsts in the 75 and 100-yard dashes as well as in the broad jump and relay to clinch honors in the seventh grade event.

The meet climaxed a month of steady practice and elimination contests. Frank Manloy, head of the city's physical education department, was in charge.
