

Track Meet Won by Pontiac High

Two Flint Schools Trail Rivals

FLINT, April 29—Pontiac High School won a three-way outdoor track meet from Flint Northern and Central, scoring 54 2-5 points to top Northern's 40 2-5 collection. Central, failing to capture a first place in the 12 events, finished last with 35 1-5 points.

Tony Piets, star Pontiac jumper, carried off high point honors with 14 counters, placing first in the pole vault and broad jump and tying for first in the high jump. Wendell Roush registered 10 points for Northern by winning the 100 and 220-yard dashes. Allan, of Pontiac, established a new field record in the shot put with a heave of 46 feet 1¾ inches.

Northern took an early lead in the meet, but was unable to match Pontiac's performers in the field events. Pontiac won seven first places to Northern's five, while Central scored heavily in seconds.

These three schools will clash again May 20 in the Saginw Valley meet, Pontiac having recently joined the conference.
