

Mt. Clemens, Pontiac Share Track Title, Pt. Huron Third

Mt. Clemens, May 13—Needing a first place in the relay race Friday to tie Pontiac for the honors in a triangular meet, Mt. Clemens team of Murray, James Mial, John Mial and Schlentz, proved equal to the task and outdistanced the Chiefs by 15 yards, sharing the title with a 57 total. Port Huron, the third contender, finished with 16 points.

Two local track records were shattered. Allen, Pontiac, tossed the shot 46 feet, 4 inches for a new mark and James Mial set the broad jump mark at 21 feet, 4 inches.
