

# BENTON HARBOR WINS TRACK TITLE

Battle Creek, May 27.—(By AP)

— Benton Harbor Junior High school won the fourth annual Southern Michigan Junior High school track and field meet for the first time here today, scoring 24 1/2 points to succeed Battle Creek Southwestern as title-holder.

Although Benton Harbor took but one first place, the youngsters from near Lake Michigan exhibited surprising power in all events and amassed enough points by winning second, third and fourth places to dethrone Southwestern.

But one record was broken, Charles Buchanan, Jackson East Intermediate, pole vaulting 9 feet 11 1/8 inches to shatter the record set two years ago by Jack Cross, of Southwestern of 9 feet 4 inches.
