

PAW PAW YOUTH PLACES FOURTH IN JAVELIN THROW

PAW PAW, June 19.—Paul Paynich, star athlete lost to Paw Paw high school by his graduation last Thursday, went to Chicago on Saturday to compete in the 29th annual National Interscholastic track and field meet at Soldier's Field.

Paynich was entered in the shot-put and javelin throw. In the first event, he was outclassed and did not place, despite having broken the state record at East Lansing a few weeks ago. In the javelin throw, Paynich placed fourth with a pitch of over 185 feet.

Richard Brockway, another local athlete, also competed in track events at Chicago, but did not place.
