

Score in All Events for Division Crown

Northwestern High's track team easily captured the West Division track championship of the City League Monday, at University of Detroit Stadium track. The Colts runners scored in every event to annex 67½ points and loom as an outstanding contender for the City title held by Hamtramck.

Cass Tech showed strength in the sprints to win runnerup honors with 34½ points; Southwestern, paced by Willie Henderson, fleet burdler, was third with 15; Mackenzie picked up enough second and third places to win fourth with 14; Chadsey and Western tied for fifth place each with six points.

Henderson was the high point winner of the meet. The Prospector star, who never has been beaten in a hurdles race outdoors in his three years competition, captured both the high and low sticks and placed second in the broad jump to score 13 points.

Colt Half Milers Stars

Michael Killinger and Vincent Daly, both of Cass Tech, walked away with the sprinting honors, accounting for 16 of their team's points in the two dashes. Killinger was clocked in :10.8 for the 100. He breasted the tape just a step ahead of his teammate.

The time was eight-tenths seconds slower than the mark set by Killinger last week when he unofficially broke the City League record with a mark of :10 flat. The record is :10.1.

Daly broke away at the start of the 220-yard dash and stayed out in front but Killinger pressed him at the finish. The time was :25.6, considered good time because the race was around two curves.

The Colts looked best in the half mile run, scoring nine points in the event, when Nelson Mashait, Ulysses Amos and Herman Hannah finished first, second and fourth, respectively. The City League 880, which will be held Saturday, is expected to be an outstanding event of the championships in view of the Colts' showing. Hamtramck also has strong middle distance runners.

Relay Team Wins Easily

Northwestern showed well in the quarter. Jack Durant won the event in :34.4 pressed by Irwin Dufour, another Colt middle distance star. The winners scored seven and one-half points in the high but Theodore Sherman's best leap was 5 feet 8 inches for first place. Glen's Bigg, of the Colts and Tim Quinn, place 47½ of the
