HARVARD FROSH FAVORING TENNIS

Cambridge, Mass., May 26.—(By AP)—As the years roll on Harvard freshmen seem to get less and less major sport minded. This year, as usual, tennis is the most popular spring activity under the Crimson's compulsory sports system. The courts have attracted 214 freshmen, 54 more than the next sport, swimming.

In major sports, crew outdistances the others with 127. Track drew 100 and baseball was a poor third with 59. The number of freshmen signed up for the other sports were in crosse, 21; basketball 19; golf, 18; gymnastium, 15; squash, 13; fencing 12; handball, 12; soccer, 8; rugby 3; and miscellaneous, 18.
