Miknavich Leads High Hurdle Prelims; Barnes, Strehl and Bullen Are in 100.

SAGINAW STAR IS OUT

East Lansing, May 26.—(AP)—Robert Kolbe of Saginaw Eastern, only Michigan high school athlete to break 10 seconds in sprint competition this spring, pulled up lame in his heat of the 100-yard dash preliminaries in class A of the track and field championships and failed to finish Saturday. Kolbe was out in front when injury to a leg muscle forced him to stop.
