

SOUTH AND UNION TRACK TEAMS WIN

Trojans Swamp Creston,
87-17, While West Siders
Beat Tech, 62-42.

PREDICTIONS JUSTIFIED

South and Union High school track teams turned in the victories expected of them in competition at South field Friday afternoon. South's win was the most one-sided, the Trojans duplicating their 87-to-17 score of last week over Catholic, this time at the expense of Creston. Union amassed 62 points to 42 for Davis Tech.

Creston took only one first against South, in the 440, where Ross and Fisher of the Bears upset the Trojan predictions. Ross had a time of 55.5 seconds, one of the best quarter-miles of the city season so far. South made sweeps in the 100-yard dash, low hurdles, shot, high jump and broad jump.

Among the exceptional marks of the South-Creston meet were Boogard's 4:52.8 in the mile, much faster than he has done hitherto; Hubbard's vault of 10 feet, 9 inches; Peevy's broad jump of 20 feet, 9 inches and the relay time of 1:36.6. In the relay South might have done better except for a slow exchange. It was thought that the first transfer was made outside the lane, but no judge had been posted on the far side of the track, so South's win stood.

In the Union meet Norb Miknavich met his first defeat in the high hurdles this year, when he nearly fell on the next to the last barrier and finished second to Kucinskas of Union. The time was 18 seconds. Norb had been under 17 seconds earlier this season.

The two best races of the Union-Tech meet were the low hurdles and the half-mile. In the hurdles Jerry Bullen of Tech beat out Kucinskas. Coffee of Union took the half mile in 2:09, when his teammate, Hutchins, drew Doane, the Tech star, into a sprint duel on the first lap and cut down his staying powers. Doane was second and Lewis of Tech third. Hutchins did not place.

Union made sweeps in the vault and high jump, and the marks in these events were not high because the boys decided to take ties and flip for the ribbons. Tech won the relay handily, as Union's only good sprinter, Rice, was unable to cut down a long Tech lead on the last lap.
