

Quarles, 13 Gain Finals for N'western

**Cass Tech Next with
Nine Qualifiers**

Taking first place in each of the three finals held, Northwestern High School's outdoor track team got off to a flying start in the quest for the West Division championship Wednesday afternoon at U. of D. Stadium. Quarles, Cole and Carson, Colt veterans, took firsts in the broad jump, shot put and pole vault, respectively. The Colts scored 18 points to four for Southwestern and Western, who were tied for second.

Northwestern also won 13 positions for the finals in the other events which are to be held Monday afternoon. Willie Henderson, Southwestern star hurdler, took individual honors Wednesday. He placed second in the broad jump and turned in the best times in qualifying in the low and high hurdles.

Cass Tech looms as Northwestern's outstanding contender. Cass scored only three points Wednesday but qualified nine of its boys for the finals. Mike Killinger, star Tech sprinter, led the way for his teammates by turning in a 10 flat performance in the 100-yard dash and :22.6 in the 220, the best of the day.
