South's '35 track team under the able guidance of "Pop" Churm, again led all the other city high school tracks teams in quest of the city track title, defeating Central at the regional meet, held at Houseman Field.

The team engaged in three dual meets with Tech, Central and Union, winning all three of them.

In the Trojans first meet they defeated the Tech thin-clads by a score of 65-39.

In their next meet Coach Churm's boys defeated the blue and gold of Central of this meet, 583/4-451/4. During the course of this meet Gillesse set a new school record of 2:07 in the 880 yard run, and Ray McDonald tied his city record of 5 feet, 11 inches in the high jump.

Following the Central meet, the Southites turned back the Union Red Hawks, 731/2-301/2.

In the city regional, South defeated the other city schools, piling up 425/8 points to 421/3 points for Central, her nearest rival.

This year's team shows promise of keeping up the old South tradition of winning the city track championship. With such veterans returning as Captain Gillesse, McDonald, Gleason, Hansma, Pifferella, Mitchell, Savage, Kemperman, Seif, Raab, Thompson, and Doltoske, Coach Churm should find little difficulty in developing another champion track team.
