TRACK

THE track team ended a successful year of representing Pontiac high school on the cinder path by coming through to finish second place in the Regional tournament after experiencing only one complete loss throughout the entire season. The squad chalked up two victories over Ferndale and Mount Clemens but fell to second place in a tri-meet with Flint Central and Flint Northern.

- Although Coach Harvey Norris had only two returning lettermen upon which to depend for experience, he rounded his crop of recruits into a squad competent enough to hold its own against the strong teams of Flint and Ann Arbor. The boys also had to overcome the loss of several stars who were unable to compete in some meets because of illness or injuries.
- The outstanding man of the season was Ledford. He set a new school record by running the one-hundred yard dash in ten seconds flat.
