

SCHOOLBOY TRACK MEET SATURDAY

Lads from 155 High Schools To Compete at East Lansing

STRONG TEAMS SIGHTED

Four hundred eager young athletes, representing 155 schools, are putting the finishing touches on their training for the state intercollegiate field and track championships to be held next Saturday at East Lansing. They are survivors of regional meets held last Saturday.

Allegan, in Class B distinguished itself by qualifying 16 men and its relay team for the state meet. Ann Arbor high won the Pre-A league meet at Ann Arbor, with Jackson second and Lansing Central third. At Kalamazoo, Muskegon captured the Class A title, Niles the Class B championship, Paw Paw, Class C, and Centreville, Class D.

At Ypsilanti, Birmingham, qualifying nine men, won the Class B title. South Lake won in Class C and Madison in Class D.

At Mt. Pleasant, Alma, qualifying nine men for the state meet, won in Class B. Edmore won in Class C and Dimondale, qualifying 10, won in Class D.

Saginaw Strong

At Saginaw, Saginaw high scored 99.25 points to win in Class A. Glio was the Class C winner and Lakesview in Class D. Watson set two new regional records in addition to a 51-foot 7-inch shot-put mark. He leaped 5 feet 11½ inches and broad jumped 21 feet 10½ inches. Wilbur Green, of Flint Central, did the 100-yard dash in 20.9 and the 220 in 22.7 but was aided by a stiff wind and the records were not allowed.

At Cadillac, Fremont won in Class B, Shelby in Class C and Onekama in Class D. Rattle of Charlevoix in Class D did the mile in 4:54.4, beating his own record of 4:58.2 set in 1934. Wile of Bear Lake in Class D leaped 5 feet 8½ inches, beating his own record. Frigies of Onekama did the 440 in 56.8 and Onekama won the relay in 1:43.5 for other regional marks.

At Dearborn, Monroe was easy winner of the Border Cities league meet, with 100.13 points. Wyandotte and Fordson high also qualified men for the state meet.

At Ferndale, River Rouge took only one first, but won the Class A meet, qualifying 11 men. Pontiac and Ferndale qualified nine men each and Royal Oak seven.

At Grand Rapids, Grand Rapids South won the Class A meet. Allegan, with 16 qualifiers in addition to the relay team, won in Class B. East Grand Rapids won in Class C and Saranac in Class D. St. Francis, however, qualified 11 men in Class D to Saranac's 6.

In the upper peninsula meet at Houghton, Escanaba won in Class B, L'Anse in Class C and Greenland in Class D.
