

## BIG REDS THIRD In Cinder test

Ann Arbor Wins Regional; Eastern High Squad

Finishes Fourth

ANN ARBOR. May 20—Lansing Central and Eastern placed third and fourth respectively in the annual 5-A league track and field championships held at Ferry field here Saturday.

The championship went to Ann Arbor with a total of 491-7 points. Jackson was in second place with 442-7 points, and the Big Reds of Central were close behind in third position with 43½ points. Eastern linished fourth with 232-7 points and Battle Creek was fifth with 1911-14 points.

Lee Barnett and Bob Morse of Central and Bill Sikes of Eastern captured the only first places for the two Lansing delegations. Barnett took first in the 440-yard dash in the time of 518. Close on his heels was Charles Brown, his teammate, who placed second. Morse provided a big upset by winning the shot put with a heave of 44 feet. Art Wade, Eastern captain, gained a third in the shot. Sikes spreadeagled the 880-yard filed, running the distance in 2:02.4. Pror of Central finished in fourth place.

ond in both the 100-yard and 220yard dashes. Roberts, Big Red negro sprinter, took a third in the 220 and a fourth in the 100-yard dash, Luther Clough, Central's crack miler, bettered the school record of

4141, but gained only a second. He was clocked in 4:40.2. Gauard and Elliott, both of Eastern, also placed in the mile, finishing fourth and fifth respectively.

"Chuck" Webb took a third in the 440-yard dash for the Quakers and Saunders and Jacobs were in a fourway ite for third in the pole vault. Darcy of Central was also in the third place ite.
