## Oilers Tackle Trucks Today

### Marquand Eyes Game Intently After Beating State, 4 to 3.

The difference between a first place tie and a half game lead in the City Class B Baseball league race will be at stake for Marquand Service in this afternoon's contest between Gulf Oil and State Truckers at Flint Park.

Gulf, the only other undefeated team in the league can match Marquand's record of three consecutive victories and gain a tie for first place with a triumph over State this afternoon. A loss for the Oilers, however, would leave Marquand perched a half game in the van.

Marquand broke up a three-way tie for the first notch yesterday by handing the Trucker team its first defeat, 4-3, at Kearsley park, and made its position at the top of the standings certain until Thursday when it will meet Gulf.

If Gulf is defeated today and tops Marquand in the Thursday encounter, both Texaco and State will have a chance of crowding up into the top row, providing they win the games on the card for them.

Texaco will be after its second victory Tuesday at Thrift City against Sprague Dalry and if it is successful will be tied with the team that loses today's contest.

Yesterday's encounter was not decided until the first half of the eighth inning. Marquand chalked up two runs in the fourth and led State until the last of the seventh when the Truckers went ahead temporarily, before the Servicemen came back to clinch it.

The game was a duel between Joe Ethier and Barney Cook, both on the mound and at the plate. Ethier led Marquand's offense, crashing out three hits in three times at bat and accounting for the winners' second run. Cook recorded State's first hit and nicked Ethier for the only home run in the game. It tied up the score in the seventh.

An error by Bud Barcombe, the only one of the game, gave State the score that put it in the lead in the seventh. Marquand's eighth inning rally that resulted in the final score was too much for State to overcome, however.

Clayton Erickson will be Manager Bill Beebe's choice against Gulf this afternoon. Walt Larson's choice is in doubt.
